Spezialist journalism is a specialized journalistic activity in which the journalist specializes in a specific subject area.

The most important subject areas include:

legal reporting, cultural journalism, medical journalism, motoring journalism, political journalism, travel journalism, sport journalism, technical journalism, environmental journalism, science journalism—and of course, **maritime journalism**.

Whereas ordinary journalism is generally learned on the job during internships and focuses on all-round skills, daily news and breadth rather than depth, specialist journalists convey expert knowledge about specialist topics in a readily understandable form

A press card provides proof of legitimate journalistic activity and thus helps to open doors during research. Based on Article 5 of the German Constitution, the State has delegated the responsibility for issuing press cards to the relevant media associations. VEUS offers its members the VEUS press card. In addition to accreditation, the press card offers a number of further benefits. For example, VEUS cooperates with pressekonditionen.de, which offers VEUS members discount and other privileges.

VEUS-LOG, the official VEUS publication, is dedicated to delivering a high standard of reporting on current topics of maritime interest.
